Alstom is present in Kazakhstan since 2010 with more than 1000 employees and after 10 years of continuous development, it now has 8 sites throughout the country: two plants: EKZ in Astana for electric locomotives production and maintenance and JV KazElectroPrivod (KEP) in Almaty for the production of point machines; three service depots, one repairing center, bogie services center and one administrative office. Alstom is the only manufacturer of electric locomotives and point machines in the Central Asian and Caucasian region and a major contributor to the revitalisation of its rail industry and the development of its economy.


